Completion expected September 11, 2011
Hudson River between NJ and NY, accessible from
Hoboken Pier A Park

Size: 100' x 150' Footbridge and freestanding island

Materials: Cast glass, light, steel, cement, & river

Description:

The memorial will be a freestanding island supported by cement piles in the Hudson River. The island has a hole cut through its center surrounded by cast borosilicate glass from which light emanates. It is reached by footbridge from edge of pier on Hoboken waterfront.
